IELTS score of 6.5 or above, with no single element below 5.5 (or equivalent). If your IELTS is below 6.5, you may still be eligible to join one of our Pre-Sessional English courses, before starting your Masters.

Don't meet the entry requirements? You may be able to study one of our Pre-Masters courses to build your academic and English language skills. Upon successful completion, subject to a minimum pass mark, you will be guaranteed a place on one of our Masters.
